

During the week ended 31st May 2019 the Fund NAV declined by 0.09% to US\$ 127.06 (previous week: US\$ 127.17), with actual portfolio yield (post-leverage) of 11.95% per annum (previous week: 12.50% p.a.), and average duration of 1.50 years (previous week: 1.52 years).



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

During the week ended 31st May 2019, we sold Macys (BBB-/Baa3/BBB) and Health & Happiness (BB+/Ba3/-) bonds.

The Fund continues to invest and book profits opportunistically for its target duration adjusted returns, details of which shall be shared in the communiques of ensuing weeks.

During the month of May 2019, the NAV of Silverdale Bond Fund declined by 0.97%. The decline in NAV was primarily due to drop in prices of Chinese credits which was partially offset by increase in prices of Turkish, US and Mexican credits. Sectorially, Consumer Cyclical sector dragged the NAV while Energy, Financial, and Industrial sectors were the key positive contributors.

We continue to maintain conservative position with circa 76% of our investments in Investment Grade bonds with short duration of just 1.50 years.
