Silverdale Bond Fund generates enhanced investor returns with low volatility, while actively managing the portfolio risks. During the month ended 27th May 2022, the Fund NAV declined by 0.44% to US\$ 90.46 (previous month: US\$ 90.86), as against Bloomberg EM USD Corporate and Quasi 1-3 years Index which declined by 0.22% and Bloomberg EM Asia USD Credit Corporate Index which declined by 1.18%. The Fund reported portfolio yield (post-leverage) of 15.25% per annum (previous month: 14.16% p.a.), and average duration of 1.73 years (previous month: 1.80 years).

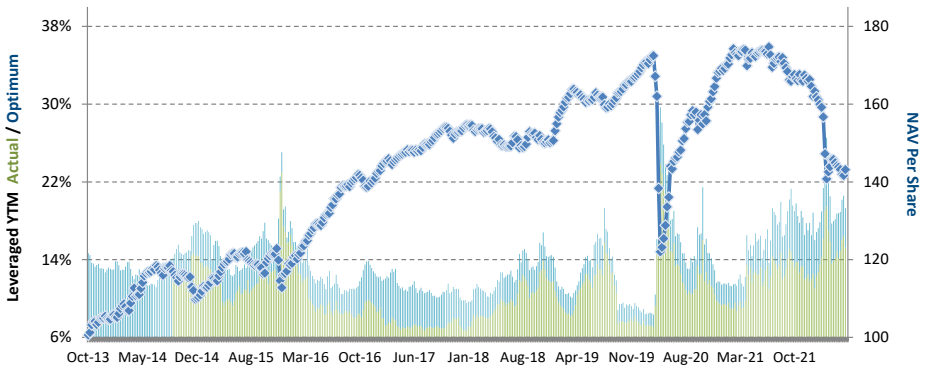

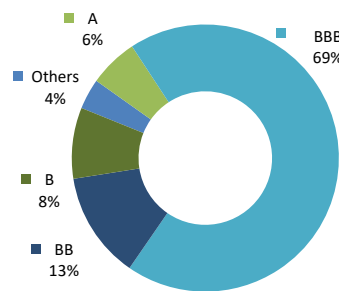

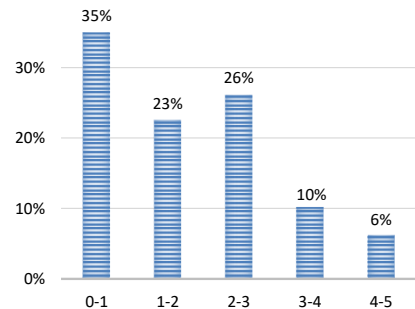

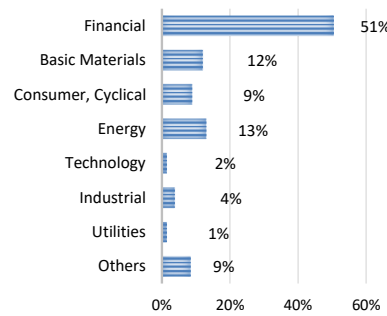

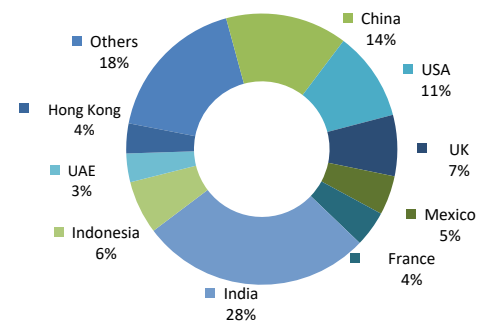

PORTFOLIO UPDATE

The month of May saw repricing of interest rate expectations lower, resulting in 1.07% spurt in NAV of Silverdale Bond Fund in the last week. The month started with increased inflation prints making the markets extremely hawkish: 10-year US Treasury peaking at 3.13%, Bloomberg EM USD Corp + Quasi-Sovereign 1-3 Year index bottoming at 255.93 while EM Asia USD Credit Corporate bottoming at 172.20. However, softening of inflation expectation, pushed down the potential rate hikes, giving wings to bond markets. The still strong US consumer spending indicated lower recession risk than that envisaged earlier, resulted in tightening of credit spreads (Bloomberg EM USD Aggregate Average OAS spread tightened by 19bps). As a result, the Fund, recovered from being 1.50% down to ending the month at -0.44% (YTD -13.95%) which compares well with Bloomberg EM USD Corporate and Quasi 1-3 years Index being down by 0.22% (YTD -7.90%) and Bloomberg EM Asia USD Credit Corporate Index being down by 1.18% return (YTD -12.30%).

Geographically, Russian, Dutch, and American credits where the key positive contributors which was partly offset by negative contribution from Chinese, Australian and German credits. While sectorially, Energy and Communications were the key positive contributors which was partly offset by drag from Financial sector.

The juxtaposition of rate hikes (which are largely priced-in) as against recession (which is likely to be milder than initially envisaged) makes markets an investment analyst's delight. With relatively higher quality (circa 75% Investment Grade) bonds, short duration of only 1.73 years, and low leverage of circa 59%, Silverdale Bond Fund is well positioned to capitalize on the opportunities in the coming quarters. The elevated leveraged yield points to potential higher portfolio returns; eventually, proving the time in the market is more important than timing the market.
