Silverdale Bond Fund targets enhanced investor returns with relatively lower volatility. During the month ended 31st March 2023, the Fund NAV decreased by 3.55% to Cum-Dividend NAV at US\$ 76.61 (previous month: US\$ 79.42), as against Bloomberg EM Asia USD Credit Corporate Index which increased by 0.94% and Bloomberg EM USD Corp and Quasi 1-3Yr Index which increased by 0.81%. The Fund has paid 32nd Quarterly Dividend of US\$ 2.10 per share resulting in the Ex-Dividend NAV of US\$ 74.51. The Fund reported portfolio yield (post-leverage) of 17.04% per annum (previous month: 13.79% p.a.), with average duration of 1.68 years (previous month: 1.66 years).

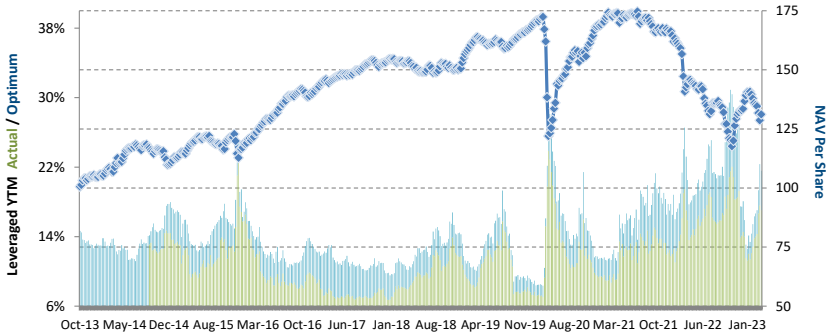

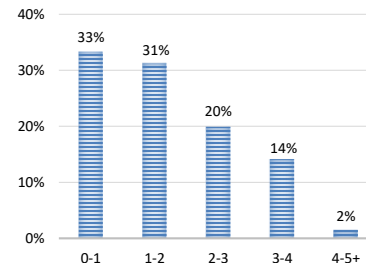

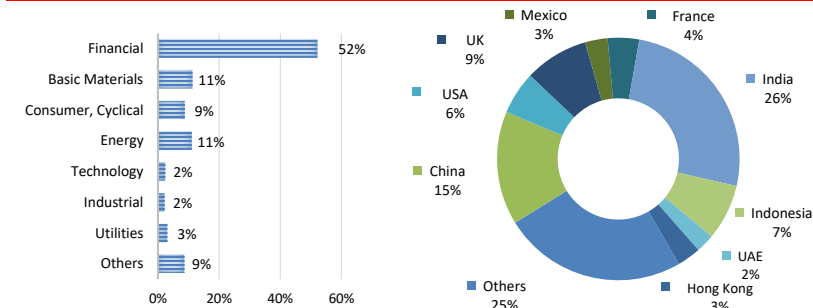

PORTFOLIO UPDATE

During the week ended 31st March 2023, Silverdale Bond Fund purchased China Modern Dairy, Haidilao, Indika Energy, Meituan, and JSW Steel bonds, while it sold Arabian Centres, and Shriram Finance bonds.

During the month, the collapse of the 16th and 19th largest banks in US, and Credit Suisse in Europe, resulted in a sharp spike in credit spreads, especially in financials and long-dated bonds. While the market is slowly digesting the news, only a part of spread increase was recouped by end of the month. The decrease in fund NAV was led by Chinese, German and British bonds, primarily due to lack of follow-up action by Chinese Govt, and the fear of contagion in Europe. Amidst the storm, Indian, Malaysian, and Indonesian bonds held up well. Sectorially, the bank failure impacted the Financial sector the most, while Energy, Basic Material and Communication sectors were resilient.

China Modern Dairy (Mkt Cap: US\$ 1.0 bn) is one of the largest dairy farmers in China with over 382,693 cows and 38 dairy farms. It sells 93% of milk to its parent company China Mengniu dairy. As of December 2022, it reported LTM revenues of US\$ 1.8bn, EBITDA of US\$ 0.2bn, and gross debt of US\$ 1.9bn resulting in gross leverage of 9.5x and interest coverage of 5.9x. The group is 56.4% owned by the China Mengniu Dairy (Mkt Cap: US\$ 19.0 bn).

PT Indika Energy Tbk (Market Cap: US\$ 851mn) is one the large thermal coal producer in Indonesia with annual production of 34 million tons, with exposure to gold mining, renewable energy, electric vehicle, and digital services. As of December 2022, it reported revenues of US\$ 4.3bn, gross debt of US\$ 1.1bn, and cash of US\$ 1.2bn resulting in gross leverage of 0.9x and effective net cash position.

Meituan (Mkt Cap: US\$ 114.0bn) is one of the largest internet platform companies in China with over 678 mn transacting users and 9.3mn active merchants. Its core businesses are food delivery, in-store hotel, and travel bookings. As of December 2022, Meituan reported revenues of US\$ 32bn, EBITDA of US\$ 0.5bn, gross debt of US\$ 8.4bn and cash of US\$ 16.2bn resulting in a net cash position of US\$ 7.8bn.

Silverdale Bond Fund continues to be positioned defensively. It never held any Credit Suisse AT1 bonds. It maintains much higher unutilized credit limits to benefit from market gyrations. 77% of its portfolio is high quality Investment Grade bonds with short duration of 1.68 years, yet has leveraged YTM of 17.04%.
